The most characteristic visual designations of the Šariš region are wooden churches and churches as well as castle ruins blended into the mountain panorama. Eyesight is essential to learn the colors of folk costumes, the intricacy of bobbin lace, admire the daring dances, the intricate buildings of the fairy-tale Bardejov, as well as the charms of the nature reserve. 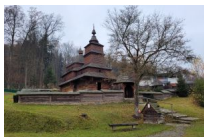

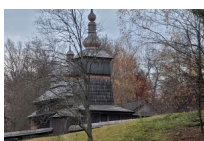

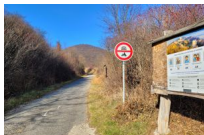
